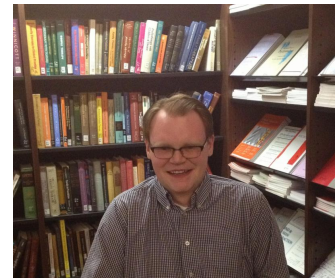
Hanns Sachs Library Newsletter
