

With the fund, generously established by Dr. and Mrs. Newman for our library, we continue building our child analysis and neuropsychology collections and can afford to subscribe to costly infant and adolescent psychotherapy journals.

Our new archival acquisition is a six volume Psychoanalytic Study of a Schizophrenic by Earl F. Zinn, circa 1935-1937, documented by the Institute of Human Relations of Yale University. A research team is being organized at BPSI to study the material.

We are in the final stages of the editorial work on the *Grete Bibring: A Culinary Biography* to be published in June.

An archival student, **Anna Dorste**, is processing eight cartons of new Sanford Gifford papers, looking for unique materials and organizing newly discovered workshops, transcripts and letters.
